Heavy rain continues and water level rises; Lan Shen Bridge at Wulai has preventive blocking.

According to the special report of torrential rain published by the Central Weather Bureau on Oct. 13, 2017 at 4:00, because of the impact of northeast wind and typhoon peripheral circulation, the mountain area in New Taipei City has occurred local heavy rain. The water level at Nanshi River goes on rising. The 10th River Management Office, WRA has executed preventive blocking at Lan Shen Bridge, Nanshi River at Wulai area this early morning (14th) at 5:30.

As expressed by the 10th River Management Office, WRA, the old street at Wulai has finished river dredging and revetment works. The right bank of Lan Shen Bridge is not high enough, so the pre-laid jumbo bags were taken advantage of making the blockage at this morning (14th) at 05:30 to prevent the old street from flooding.

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
