V: Directions from the Director:

1. According to the data from the Central Weather Bureau, rainfall will not slow down until 15<sup>th</sup> at 8:00. The accumulated rainfalls in the northern and eastern parts keep on increasing, so each unit shall continue monitoring the relevant disaster information.
2. Council of Agriculture, Executive Yuan and the Ministry of the Interior are requested to supervise all the counties/cities governments to publish the mudslide warning zones at the potential tribes and grasp the instant rainfall situation in order to inform the first line local leaders of the townships and villages at proper time to make the preventive evacuation preparation works as good as possible.
3. Ministry of Transportation and Communications shall execute the subsequent early warning of road closure works for the important highways at the warning zones along with local counties and cities governments. In addition, for the collapsed road section at provincial highway No. 7 at 93K, Ministry of Transportation and Communications shall finish the emergent repair work rapidly to reduce the impact on traffic.
4. In regards to the disaster cases reported by the mass, each unit shall take the initiative to instantly provide the handling condition and related information.
