Keep alert! Level 2 Central Emergency Operations Center Established

In response to the impact of peripheral circulation of Typhoon Khanun along with northeast monsoon, Water Resources Agency, Ministry of Economic Affairs has established Level 3 Disaster Emergency Response Team of Water Resources Agency on Oct. 11, 2017 at 22:00 and upgraded to Level 2 of Ministry of Economic Affairs on Oct. 13, 2017 at 21:00, and upgraded again to be the establishment of Level 2 Central Emergency Operations Center at 23:30.

As expressed by Ministry of Economic Affairs, affected by the northeast wind and typhoon peripheral circulation, today (14th) the mountain zones at the north, Hualien, Taitung and Pingtung areas have heavier rain. Since the continuous rainfall for many days, people are reminded of paying attention to sudden heavy rains, thunderbolts and strong gusts. Landslides at mountain areas, falling rocks, mudslides and stream surges shall be paid attention; low-lying sites shall be cautious of flooding; driving and traffic shall be kept alert. In addition, people are appealed to take notice of flood warning message to make good preparation to prevent from flood.
