

Typhoon CIMARON Disaster Response Report - 1st Report

I. Typhoon Summary (Source: Central Weather Bureau)

The Central Weather Bureau issued sea typhoon alert for mild typhoon Cimaron at 10.30 July 17th 2013. The center of Cimaron is located at 19.9N, 120.6E at 17:30. The coordinate indicates relative position 230 km south of Eluanbi. Cimaron is now estimated a scale 7 storm with a radius of 100 km, traveling 19 km/hour towards northwest and north-north west. Currently, the center of Cimaron is passing the sea area south of Eluanbi and moving towards northwest. The typhoon has entered Bashi Channel, posing as a threat to the sea areas of Bashi Channel, Taiwan Strait, and Dongsha Islands. Vessels active on the seas of Bashi Channel, Taiwan Strait, and Dongsha Islands are advised to take extra caution. Affected by its peripheral circulation, there are chances of local violet rain in the mountain areas of Taitung and Hualien, as well as the Hengchun Peninsula today (17th), and local heavy rain in Taitung, Hualien, and mountain areas of Western Taiwan. Residents in the above areas are advised to taken precaution for instantaneous heavy rain, lightening, and strong gusts. Long waves are expected in the coastal areas of Southwest and Southeast Taiwan (including Lanyu and Green Island), Hengchun Peninsula, and Penghu. Persons active at the shores are advised to stay alert of the waves.
