

Typhoon Talim Disaster Response Reports — 2nd Report

Data as of 21:00, June 19, 2012

1. Typhoon Summary (Data source: Central Weather Bureau)

Weak typhoon Typhoon Talim's center was at 8:30pm on June 19th 2012, over the sea at latitude 20.4 north and longitude 116 east, approximately 510 kilometers southwest of Penghu; it has a Force 7 wind typhoon radius of 150 kilometers and is moving northeast at 20kmh, becoming 28kmh. It is estimated that the speed it moves will increase and wind and rain will worsen across Taiwan; on land, the Penghu and Kinmen areas should be on high alert and take precautions against strong winds and torrential rain; at sea: ships passing through or working in the sea around Dongsha, the Bashio Channel, Taiwan Straits and the sea area off north Taiwan should remain on high alert; the southwest coast of Taiwan, the Hengchun Peninsula, the southeast coast, Green Island, Orchid Island and Penghu are already seeing large waves and quite strong gusts of wind; Please keep away from the seashore; also, at spring high tide times, people of low-lying coastal areas should be on the guard against sea water encroachment.
