

Typhoon Talim Disaster Response Reports — 1st Report

Data as of 11am June 19, 2012

1. Typhoon Summary (Data source: Central Weather Bureau)

Weak typhoon Typhoon Talim's center at 8:30am on June 19th, 2012 was over the sea at latitude 19.4 north and longitude 114.6 east approximately 690 kilometers southwest of Penghu; it has Force 7 wind storm radius of 150 kilometers and is moving northeast at 16-21 kilometers an hour. Its storm radius is gradually approaching the southern end of the Taiwan Straits, representing a threat to the Straits and the Bashio Channel; the southwest coast of Taiwan, the Hengchun Peninsula, the southeast coast, Green Island, Orchid Island and Penghu are already seeing large waves and quite strong gusts of wind; Please keep away from the seashore; also, at spring high tide times people of low-lying coastal area should be on the guard against sea water encroachment.
